




Marigold Street Reserve

Marigold Street Reserve is a house block sized corner reserve located in Wendouree. The reserve contains a small, dilapidated play area and a stand of established trees. There was dumped rubbish, shopping trolleys and broken glass scattered around the reserve.

Engagement feedback was low for Marigold Street Reserve with 3 surveys completed and 2 visitors to the drop in session (held jointly with Clover Street Reserve).

How do you use Marigold Street Park?

Of those responding, one reported using the reserve with children. The others didn't use it or would use it if it was improved.



What would you like to see changed in the reserve?

The most commonly requested improvements were repairs to the fencing, a new footpath to allow access to the play area and improved play equipment. Improvements to play included active play elements like sports goals or a basketball ring.

What would you like to see remain the same?

The elements that people enjoyed and would like to remain in the space are the presence of a playground that was separate from the unplanned open grassy space sometimes used for ball games. Others reported enjoying the presence of the trees.

Theme

Flowers were suggested as a theme for the reserve.

Recommendations for Design

- Consider improvements to Clover Street and Marigold Street Reserves together offering a different experience at each reserve. Opportunity to add Primrose Street Reserve into the design outcome.
- Clean up the broken glass and dumped rubbish
- Remove existing post and rail fence and replace with a more aesthetic barrier
- Remove and renew the playground
- Add shaded seating area and a path leading to the existing footpath.
- Increase provision of shade through tree and habitat planting.
